Telegraph, telephone and unsigned Entries Cannot be accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are Not Acceptable.

Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. **No Refund** for Bitches in season in Obedience/Rally

Owners are Responsible For Errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Veteran Dog: for dogs at least 7 years of age (same class for bitches). Spayed bitches and neutered dogs eligible for Veterans Class

Field Trial Dog: for dogs that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or who have been awarded an AKC Hunting Test Title or who have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Rating prior to the closing date of this Show.(same class for bitches).

Best of Breed Competition

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog: for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed or some Non-Regular Class other than Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch: substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the Judges decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
